

**Nationwide Prescription Drug Take-Back Day:**

This spring, the Drug Enforcement Administration and its national and community partners will give the public another opportunity to prevent pill abuse and theft by ridding their homes of potentially dangerous expired, unused, and unwanted prescription drugs. On Saturday, April 30<sup>th</sup> from 10 AM until 2 PM, the Drug Enforcement Administration and its partners will hold the National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day. The service is free and anonymous with no questions asked. The following collection sites will be accepting these drugs:
