

Advisory: New adaptive technology to ease traffic congestion on Route 22.

Project to be implemented on Tue 7/31.

Rhythm Engineering will be implementing an adaptive traffic signal system on State Route 22 starting Tuesday, July 31st. The ultimate goal will be to ease congestion through the Business 22 corridor from the Rodi Rd interchange through Monroeville and Murrysville. 14 signals should be going live by Tuesday afternoon. These will act in concert with those already in place in Monroeville. Once live, traffic signals will change according to fluctuations of congestion and attempt to alleviate it by changing the lights accordingly. As the system learns the rhythm of congestion, you should expect different patterns of signal changes. Be assured that an engineer is monitoring the lights and making adjustments. Please be aware and extra cautious as the motoring public adjusts to this new system.
